## **Jobs & Workforce Stability**

**Key words: Employment | Immigration | Bilingualism**

**Creating a bilingual job growth environment where government and private sectors attract and retain skilled workers.**

We will foster stable employment by encouraging cooperation between public and private sectors, ensuring jobs are available and accessible in both English and French. Newly landed immigrants will benefit from fast-tracked certification recognition, allowing them to work in their fields without delay. We will also extend language-learning timeframes to help newcomers fully integrate and contribute.

## **Affordable Living & Housing Security**

**Key words: Affordability | Housing Rights | Equity**

**Tackling the housing crisis as a human right, not a commodity, putting people's needs before politics.**

Adequate housing is a fundamental right, as recognized by international human rights documents (UDHR Article 25, ICESCR Article 11.1). We will introduce a housing tax credit for families earning under \$40,000 annually to directly ease affordability pressures. This approach aims to reduce homelessness, increase housing stability, and ensure everyone can live with dignity.

### **Cutting costs for Quebecers by fighting price-gouging and reducing taxes.**

We will investigate and call out price-gouging across all industries, with particular focus on grocery chains and real estate, protecting consumers from unfair inflation of essential goods and services. An immediate reduction of the Quebec Sales Tax (QST) from 9.975% to 8% will provide direct, tangible relief to families, helping them keep more money in their pockets.

Modernizing Quebec's tax system for fairness, simplicity, and growth.

We propose two new personal income tax brackets to ensure higher earners contribute their fair share: 25.75% for incomes \$112,655–\$250,000 and 28% for incomes above \$250,000. This shift balances tax fairness, with projected savings for lower and middle earners. Eliminating Revenue Quebec and transferring tax collection to the CRA will reduce duplication, simplify compliance, and improve efficiency. Surplus revenues will be directed to the Generational Fund to lower Quebec's public debt, securing economic stability for future generations.

At the same time, we recognize that current tax structures often discourage local business creation and push talent and capital elsewhere. We oppose giving massive tax breaks to multinational corporations in exchange for short-term job headlines—these deals rarely deliver long-term value. Instead, we support reducing the tax burden on individuals and Canadian-owned businesses to foster real, sustainable economic growth at home.

We believe in rewarding innovation, entrepreneurship, and effort—not penalizing success. Our vision is for a balanced, competitive tax environment that strengthens the middle class, supports local job creators, and ensures prosperity is built and shared right here in Quebec.
